



Justification: Recommendations / II. All facilities shall document the justification process in the proper manner and are normally expected to use the referral guidelines made available by the Professional Bodies. [This makes the justification process straightforward and helps to avoid unnecessary and repeated exposures. The justification process should also include the review of the patient history. Referral guidelines must be available for the referrer and must be reviewed on a regular basis.]





Justification: Good Practices and Limiting Factors

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Following proper training (with experience and competence) and clear responsibilities and tasks a radiographer may be able to validate justification in several cases. (UK)
